Enclosed you will find:

- A schedule of Journeyman classes for Eugene through August 31, 2019;
- A schedule of STAR and REFRESHER classes in Portland through March 31, 2018;
- A Registration Form; with a new spot for your e-mail for easier communication; and
- Procedures for obtaining the Respirator Medical Evaluation and Fit Test (see back of Class Registration Form)

Please note that there are changes to the STAR program,

Minimum requirements to qualify for the STAR Bonus:

- **Work greater than 1000 hrs. for the contract year**
- **Attend, at minimum, 4 monthly Union meetings during the contract year**
- **Be in good standing with Local 10 membership by the end of contract year**

STAR bonus program:

- **Level I:** All required classes completed (regardless of completion date) plus 8 hrs. of (STAR) classes \$400
- **Level II (a):** All required classes completed within the last 3 years plus 8 hrs. (STAR) classes earns a \$300 kicker, total \$700
- **Level II (b):** If all required courses are NOT current in the last 3 years take 8 hrs. of Safety Refreshers or Participate in your employer's "Monthly Company Safety Meetings" totaling 8 hrs., plus 8 hrs. (STAR) classes for the \$300 kicker, total \$700
- **Level III:** If all required courses are current in the last 3 years and you have 16 hrs. of (STAR) classes you are eligible to take part in the Regional Training Center's "Apprenticeship Mentor Program" for an additional \$300 kicker
- **Total potential bonus \$1000**

Why the redesign?

Due to low participation rates over the last few years, the "STAR" program is at risk of being dis-continued going forward. As local 10 and District Council 5 members each of us has the opportunity to turn this trend around. The goal of the redesign is to strengthen "Union Solidarity" through **safety, mastery of skills and knowledge sharing**. This can only happen with your help and participation.

Contact the Regional Training Center to sign up for a "STAR" Program Orientation.

Additional Apprentices requirements:

- Zero unexcused absences from training classes
- Zero late MPR's
- Zero citations

Apprentice Mentorship Program:

- You must be, at minimum, third-year apprentice to qualify as a mentor (4000 OJT hrs and 288 classroom hrs).
- Mentors will be assigned a first or second year apprentice.
- Mentors will need to share experiences of how they have made a career in painting, share experiences and be open for questions.
- Having a mentor does not imply an apprentice needs help. Apprentices have proven they have the attitude, skill-set and knowledge to make it. Having your support will help guide them to success throughout their careers.
- Being a mentor can have a powerful impact on apprentices and journeymen alike. This program will take both the apprentice and mentor to come up with a solid, positive plan that will be presented to the RTC Coordinator that promotes professionalism, craftsmanship and positive outcomes.
- We are the next generation of paint craftsmen and women. The apprentices you impact today are going to be the leaders of tomorrow. As a mentor you will influence the future by taking responsibility to help a first or second year apprentice succeed.

Reminders:

- STAR hours (previously called elective hours) do not carry over to the new contract year. You will need to be current with all required classes to qualify for a bonus check on April 1, 2019.
- OSHA 30 is required for all commercial and industrial painters.
- If by 24 hours prior to the class fewer than six people have pre-registered, the class may be canceled and those who signed up will be notified by phone immediately. Be sure your contact information with us is up to date.
- You will be charged \$25 for classes you register for but do not attend (\$65 for medical screenings), and you will not be able to attend future classes until paid. You will NOT be charged a fee if you call and cancel at least 24 hours in advance of the class start time. **Unpaid missed class fees will disqualify a journeyman for the STAR award.**

**Procedures for Obtaining a Respirator Medical Evaluation and Fit Test
Painters Union Management Partnership (PUMP) Program**

Step 1 – Medical Evaluation

You must have had a respirator medical questionnaire and pulmonary function test within the last three years. If you already have a current medical evaluation on file at the Training Center, skip to Step 2.

If you haven't had a medical evaluation with an Occupational Health clinic within the last three years, you or your employer will need to request a voucher from the Training Center and then schedule an appointment. This program is paid for by the PUMP Program. Please note that if you fail to show up for a scheduled appointment, you will be charged \$50.

When the medical evaluation is complete, you will be given a Respirator Medical Certification letter explaining respirator limitations, if any. ***Make sure to bring this with you to the fit test appointment, and make a copy for your employer!***

Step 2 – Respirator Fit Test

Call the Regional Training Center and schedule a respirator training session and fit test. To schedule an appointment, phone 503-287-4856. Bring your Medical Certification letter with you or you will have to reschedule the fit test. The training session is a user-friendly computer program developed by the Oregon Health Sciences University and takes about one hour to complete.

When you have finished the computer training, you will be given a Fit Test. If this is your first fit test, a respirator will be issued to you. If you are returning for the annual training and fit test, bring your respirator with you.
